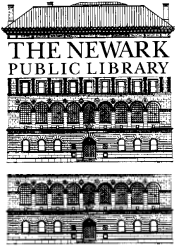

Abstract

The Charles F. Cummings Papers consist of drafts, notes, research files, administrative material, correspondence, exhibit labels, photographs, etc. related to Cummings' work in the New Jersey Information Center and other areas of the Newark Public Library; his writings, talks, tours, and exhibits related to Newark history; and his interest in, and advocacy for, the City of Newark.

Provenance

This collection comprises material from Cummings' office at NPL and from his home, gathered by library staff soon after his death; much of the chronological correspondence, however, was transferred from the New Jersey Information Center to the collection in September 2013.

Biographical Note

Charles Franklin Cummings was born in Puerto Rico in 1937, the only child of Ola and Charles Cummings. The family moved to Maine shortly after his birth, but remained there only briefly. Charles, Sr. died young, and Ola headed south with her son. Cummings was raised in Virginia and graduated from Washington-Lee High School in Arlington, Virginia in 1955. He attended the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa (AB, 1959), did graduate work in American History at Vanderbilt University (MA, 1964), and later earned an MLS degree from Rutgers University.

Cummings arrived in Newark in 1963 and joined the Newark Public Library (NPL) staff on July 15th of that year. He worked first as a reference librarian in the New Jersey Information Center under the direction of Miriam Studley, who had led the department since the 1940s. Cummings subsequently held a variety of positions at the Library, including Assistant Director for Special Collections, Director of Statewide Outreach, and Acting Director of the NPL, but he is best known for his work as Head of the Library's New Jersey Information Center, which is now named for him. He added substantially to the Center's collections of Newark-related material, curated several historical exhibits, and became widely known as an authority on and advocate for Newark history. He also taught Newark history as an Adjunct Professor at Rutgers University-Newark.

His column, "Knowing Newark," appeared regularly in the *Star-Ledger* (1996-2005), and he wrote or co-authored a number of books, including "Remembering Essex: A Pictorial History of Essex County," "Newark: The Golden Age," "Newark: An American City," and "History of Newark, New Jersey, 1666-2002." Among the many exhibits that he curated were: "Photos by Dorer: American Photographer and New Jersey Chronicler"; "Remembering Newark's Greeks: An American Odyssey"; "Through the Lens of the *Star-Ledger*"; "Faces of Newark, 1666-1999"; "The Vanishing First Ward: Newark's Little Italy"; and "Lasting Impressions: The Jewish Legacy of Greater Newark."

Cummings was a charter member of the Newark Preservation and Landmarks Committee, and was much in demand as a speaker and a leader of walking tours. At the time of his death Cummings was Newark City Historian, a position he had held since 1988 when appointed by Mayor Sharpe James and the City Council; and Assistant Director of Special Collections at the NPL. He was co-recipient of the New Jersey Council for the Humanities "Public Humanities Award" (2005), and received several other awards and honors.

Charles Cummings died suddenly on December 21, 2005. His funeral was held at Grace Episcopal Church, where he had been an active member; he was buried in Mount Pleasant Cemetery.

Scope and Content

The Charles F. Cummings Papers consist largely of notes, drafts, newspaper clippings, and other research materials associated with his "Knowing Newark" columns; files on talks and tours given by Cummings; and background material and labels for exhibits curated by Cummings, NPL librarians or guest curators. Also in the files are minutes, memos, and other printed material relating to Newark Public Library administration; material on organizations in which Cummings participated, including the New Jersey Historical Society, Newark's Bicentennial Committee (which he chaired), the New Jersey Historical Commission, and the New Jersey Library Association, among others; and a small amount of correspondence, both personal and professional, and photographs.

The collection is arranged in nine series.

Series 1: Writings, 1909-2004 (Bulk: 1960s-2004), Undated

This series contains manuscripts, drafts, notes, and assorted research material primarily related to the "Knowing Newark" columns Cummings wrote for the Newark Star-Ledger (1996-2005). Also contained here is material related to other projects in which Cummings was involved, and a small amount of material by other authors.

Subseries 1.1. "Knowing Newark" 1909-2004, Undated (Bulk: 1960s-2004)

This subseries, related to Cummings' "Knowing Newark" columns published in the Newark Star-Ledger (1996-2005), comprises notes, drafts, chronologies, and lists; research material consisting primarily of photocopies of clippings (obituaries, news items, etc.), and articles; and a small number of pamphlets or printed materials such as "Bamberger's Guide to Wine," c. 1930s (Box 3, Folder 15). The subject of these columns is Newark, but Cummings often situates Newark in state and national history and affairs. Some of the research material may also be associated with other projects, including exhibits or books.

A complete run of the "Knowing Newark" columns (March 7, 1996 to December 29, 2005) is available in the CFC-NJIC.

The material is arranged alphabetically by subject. The dates of photocopied material are bracketed.

Subseries 1.2. General, 1974-2004, Undated

Contained here are drafts and notes related to articles, sketches, and a few brief pieces by Cummings; and the writings of several others, including, but not limited to, a complete manuscript of Gordon Bishop's "Greater Newark: A Microcosm of America" (Chatsworth, CA: Windsor Publications, 1989) with annotations, edits, and at least one chapter by Cummings; an autographed, corrected proof of "The Lottery Winner" by Mary Higgins Clark; and the draft of a young adult novel, set in Newark, by Barbara Krasner-Khait.

The Cummings material is arranged alphabetically by title; the material by others is arranged alphabetically by author.

Series 2: Talks and Tours, 1973-2005, Undated

This series contains notes, drafts, handouts, research materials, itineraries, and a small amount of correspondence related to talks given, and tours led, by Cummings.

Subseries 2.1. Talks, 1973-2005

Found here are notes, outlines, talking points, and drafts of addresses given by Cummings at a variety of professional, academic, business, or civic events including conferences, exhibits, anniversaries, tributes, dedications, etc. The topics, although primarily related to Newark history, culture, and development, also include professional library topics such as newspaper indexing and preservation.

The folder titles list the topic or title of the talk, if known, or the organization to which the talk was given. The material is arranged chronologically.

Subseries 2.2. Tours, 1973-2004, Undated

This subseries consists primarily of itineraries, handouts, and research materials related to bus and walking tours conducted by Cummings; and a small amount of correspondence regarding arrangements for the tours including suggestions for lunch, with Forno's being recommended most frequently. The tours were often associated with a conference or particular event in Newark. Many of the files are quite brief, including little more than the name of the organization and the date of tour, but they attest to the range of groups that Cummings led — everyone from nearby historical societies to a delegation from South Africa (2004). Among the tours with the most substantial amount of material are: Mt. Pleasant Cemetery (1980-1981, 1994), Victorian Society (1995, 1998), Philip Roth documentary — tour for German crew (1998); Skyscrapers (1998), Culinary walking tour for the New School (1999), and Portuguese Culinary Delights (1999).

Also included are three tours outside of Newark: Jersey City, Essex County-West, and Perth Amboy.

The folder titles list the subject of the tour, if known, or the organization to which the tour was given. The material is arranged chronologically.

Series 3: Subject Files, 1862-2005 (Bulk: 1970s-2005)

These files consist of notes, reports, clippings, programs, brochures, agendas, photographs, correspondence, etc. related primarily to organizations, committees, and conferences with which Cummings was involved.

Subseries 3.1. Organizations and Committees, 1972-2005

This subseries comprises material related to many of the professional and civic organizations with which Cummings was associated through his work at the NPL and as City Historian, or as a citizen and advocate for the City of Newark.

Organizations and activities that are well represented in this subseries include the [Newark] Bicentennial Commission (Chairman, 1974-1977); New Jersey Library Association (organized NJLA's 1974 annual meeting in Newark, and member of History and Bibliography Section, Committee on the Bibliography of the Negro, 1966-1975); and the Newark Preservation and Landmarks Committee (founding member, and long-time board member). The material also documents the range of his local commitments, including, but not limited to: Connection Newark: participant in strategic planning meeting (1998); Episcopal Church, Diocese of Newark: Task Force on History; Municipal Careermen of Newark: Vice-president (1978); New Jersey Historical Society: library committee; Newark Festival of People: ad-hoc committee (1985-1987); Newark Master Plan: Cummings was asked for "any input" regarding a draft reexamination report on Newark's 1990 Master Plan (1999); Newark Public Information Office: assisted with research and writing of promotional material; and Newark Renaissance: advisory committee, and author of the column "Windows on Newark."

The material is arranged alphabetically.

Subseries 3.2. General, 1889-2002, Undated

This small subseries contains a variety of material including, pamphlets, articles, programs, conference hand-outs, a book created by school children from Newark-on-Trent for students at the 14th Avenue School, and a folder of material related to Beatrice Winser (including memos on staff appearance and decorum, correspondence, and her statement regarding the appointment of Archibald MacLeisch as Librarian of Congress).

Subseries 3.3. Herman A. Estrin, circa 1960-1986

Herman A. Estrin (1915-1999) joined the New Jersey Institute of Technology (then the Newark College of Engineering) as an instructor in English in 1946; by his retirement in 1981, he had been Chair of the Humanities Department for 13 years, and was a full professor. Estrin served as president of the New Jersey Council of Teachers of English, and founded the New Jersey Literary Hall of Fame.

This subseries consists primarily of material related to New Jersey author awards presented annually by the New Jersey Council of Teachers of English. The correspondence, to and from Estrin, includes at least one letter from each of the following authors or scholars: Svetlana Alliluyeva, John Ciardi, M. Jean Craig, George Kennan, John McPhee, Philip Roth (who questioned honorable mention), Gay Talese, and John Unterecker.

Subseries 3.4. First Fidelity, 1862-1991 (Bulk: 1930s-1980s)

This small subseries contains photographs, clippings, and other material related to the history of the National State Bank and First Fidelity.

Series 4: Calendars, Desk Diaries, and Notebooks, 1963-2005, Undated

The material in this series documents not only Cummings' daily appointments at the NPL but also his appointments related to church affairs, community events, and committee meetings; details regarding talks, tours, and exhibits; personal activities such as dinners with friends, travel, and leisure pursuits; and addresses and phone numbers.

The later desk diaries act in some ways as scrapbooks and include business cards of individuals and businesses, clippings, tickets to concerts, museums, exhibits, etc. and more detailed descriptions of activities and events.

The pocket diaries contain the briefest of records, but can be illuminating even in their brevity. Consider this entry from the week of November 18, 1974 for example:

"Harris kept very good order

Meeting interrupted by

1 - cursing & moving about

2 - sneezing

3 - prolong. applause

4 - Riot broke out

Baraka showed to agitate, Mrs. Jones showed up

Meeting disrupted 1 hour -- cat call; Earl takes 10% off top; police refused to remove agitators; screams of Heil Hitler; character assn. of council president; screams radical; fascism shouting; Harris called fag;"

Series 5: Personal, circa 1947-2005

This small series contains yearbooks, a childhood diary (with very few entries), a Boy Scout Patrol Book, profiles and resumes, Cummings' will, and material related to the estate of Cummings' mother Ola Hearn Mattingly (1907-1997), among other items.

Series 6: Correspondence, 1967-2005

The bulk of the material in this series is arranged chronologically, and contains routine, incoming and outgoing correspondence regarding reference requests (some of which were answered by other librarians including Karen Gilbert and James Stuart Osbourn); permissions to use material; acknowledgments of donations; a few letters of complaint or praise; and details regarding exhibitions, conferences, meetings, talks, tours, workshops, etc. Correspondents include the general public; other librarians, historians or genealogists; local business and civic leaders; and journalists. The geographic range of the correspondents is primarily Newark and New Jersey, but includes a few correspondents from around the country and globe.

One folder contains "protest letters" regarding the removal of Cummings as Head of the New Jersey Reference Division, and his re-assignment as assistant director for Statewide Outreach, with letters from John T. Cunningham, Elizabeth Del Tufo, Kenneth Jackson, and Clement A. Price (1995) among others, along with responses from Betty S. Rufalo, president of the NPL Board of Trustees.

Also included is a small amount of personal material from "home files," consisting of notes, cards, and information regarding a family wedding.

A few letters are filed by correspondent; these include Sharpe James, Philip Roth, Julia Sabine, and Lowell Weiss (special assistant to President Bill Clinton) among others.

Finally the series includes two postcards and one letter written to Hannah ("Honey") and Leo Litzky from Hannah's brother, Louis Ginsberg, and nephew, the poet Allen Ginsberg. These items were found among the exhibit files for "Newark's Jewish Heritage," an exhibit which was held in 1995.

Series 7: Exhibits, 1904-2005, Undated (Bulk: 1970-2005)

The majority of the material in this series is related to exhibits with which Cummings was involved, but the series also contains material from exhibits that pre-dated Cummings' tenure at NPL, and exhibits that were created by other staff members of NPL, including William Dane. Dan Schnur was responsible for the installation of many of the exhibits in this series.

The bulk of this series consists of labels and narratives for exhibits. Also in this series are notes and research materials, clippings, and press releases; exhibit catalogues and other printed materials; and a few photographs. Individual items in the series that may have been exhibited include: "Mary Higgins Clark Mystery Magazine," Premier Issue (NJ Literary Hall of Fame exhibit, 1997); and in over-size box 41: six large pencil portraits of [New Jersey writers?] by William "Bill" Canfield, who worked at the Newark News, and later the Newark Star-Ledger as a cartoonist and staff artist; sheet music, with covers, for two songs related to the 250th anniversary of Newark's founding: "Come to Newark and Have a Jubilee," and "Take Me Back to Dear Old Newark," both 1916; photographs and sketches of Mary Higgins Clark (as a child), John Cunningham (a snapshot as a young reporter), and Belva Plain.

The material is arranged chronologically by exhibit.

Series 8: Photographs and other Media, 1960s-2004, Undated

This series consists primarily of slides that likely were used in conjunction with talks, but also includes a few photographs of library events, and computer disks that may contain material related to exhibits.

Series 9: Library Administration, 1967-2005, Undated

This series contains material related to the administration of the Newark Public Library including: often extensive notes and minutes of Council meetings (1989-2003), budgets, grant applications, collection guides, proposals, memos, reports, feasibility studies, and outreach and development material. The material reflects the range of Cummings' work at the NPL, which included, among other responsibilities: reorganization of the business library (1980s); development, fundraising, and outreach; facility design; preservation and conservation projects such as the microfilming of the Newark Evening News, indexing of the Newark Star-Ledger, digitization projects and disaster planning; the creation of collection policies, book selection, personnel issues, etc.

Also in this series are broadsides, maps, and guides related to the City of Newark, and NJPAC programs.

The material is arranged alphabetically.

Personnel files in this series (Box 45, Folders 16-17; and Box 49, Folders 29-30, 32, and 34-36) are restricted until 75 years after the creation of the documents.
