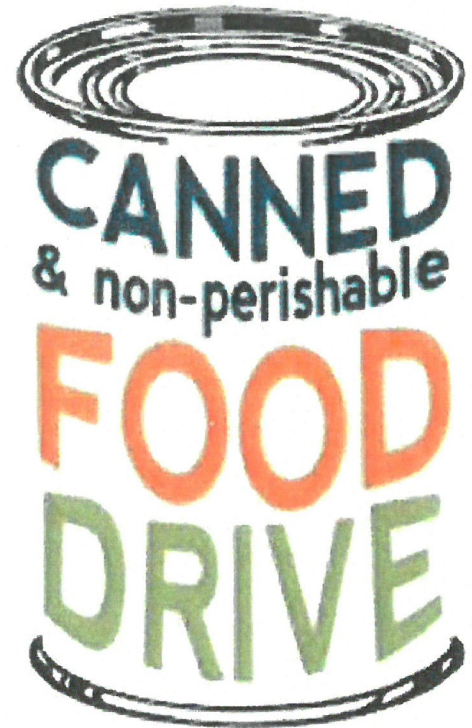


Summer of 2017 **Fine** Forgiveness

2. Library borrowers who bring non-perishable food for Essex County pantries* will have their fines waived.

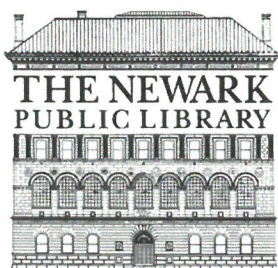


Program Details

- June 19 through September 9.
- Fines on one overdue item will be waived for each food item.
- Items must be returned. Fees for lost, damaged, or interlibrary loan materials will not be waived.
- Food for the pantries will be accepted at all Library locations.

Patrons are encouraged to bring canned goods or items in boxes or plastic jars to any Library location in exchange for fine forgiveness.
